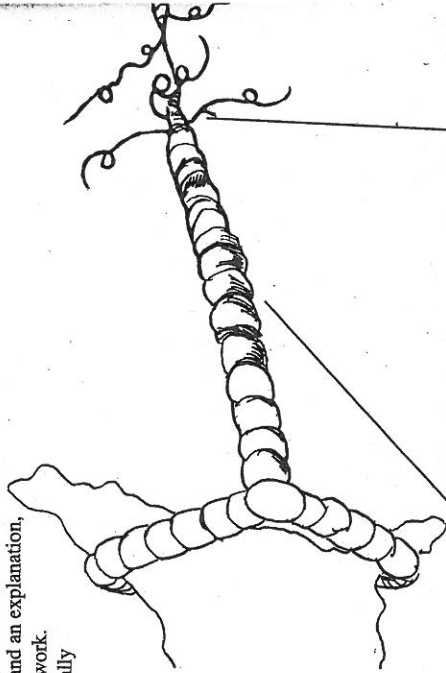

After you complete a symbol and an explanation, have your teacher check your work. The first strand has been partially completed for you.

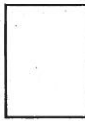

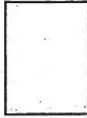
